

## Driving School Parent,

As I'm sure you know teaching your daughter or son to be a life long safe member of the driving community is extremely important. We are honored that you chose **Certified Driving School** as your partner to accomplish this ultra important task!

Knowing this may be your first time to work with a newbie driver, we wanted to make sure you were aware of your role and then to give you some tools to better help you with your part.

We teach the basics in the classroom and then drive with your child for 6 hours to instill these in your son or daughter's skill set. Afterwards you are required by Oklahoma law to drive 50 hours with them to reinforce these skills. Forty hours should be driven in daytime hours and 10 hours at night. Nights lit up with a big, bright full moon are an excellent time to do this.

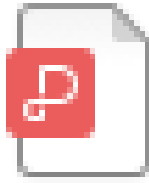
Please use the **Road Ready App** on your child's phone to record this activity as it will be required when it's time to road test.
